

NAME

binit - moves the file(s) specified to the Windows recycle bin

SYNOPSIS

```
binit <input-files>
```

DESCRIPTION

The akiwi bin-it program moves the specified files to the Windows recycle bin. File names may include ? or * wildcards, but these wildcards can only be placed in the filename portion of the path.

Several other recycle utilities may be found on the internet, but most of these fail to provide adequate status messages and may fail silently if anything goes wrong.

Unlike these, bin-it provides comprehensive status and error messages so you can plainly see if there was a problem during command execution.

EXAMPLES**Example 1**

```
binit foo.txt
```

Sends the file named foo.txt to the Windows recycle bin.

Example 2

```
binit *.txt *.bak
```

Sends all files in the current directory with extensions .txt or .bak to the Windows recycle bin.

Example 3

```
binit c:\temp\?2015.csv
```

Sends all files that match the pattern ?2015.csv in the c:\temp directory to the Windows recycle bin. The first character of the filename can be variable.
